When you have learned this minor scale the other minor scales have exactly the same fingering





The Harmonic minor scale is made up of 3 triangles. Let us explore this more.











Stage 1 find A with your second finger

3 steps up from C


Or 1 step down from E



place your second finger on A





Locate B. This is directly behind G. Use your 3rd finger




Locate C with your 4th finger. C has an indentation or marked with a stone

This completes our first triangle






We have to complete our 2nd triangle and locate E. With your 3rd finger find E. This is just behind C




Almost there. Time to start our last triangle and finish the scale

> Let us find F with our 4th Finger. This is 1 below C

With a big stretch we have to find G#. This is behind E. Use your 2nd Finger




The final step and complete our triangle. Move over to A with your 3rd finger




lets go back down in 3 triangles
